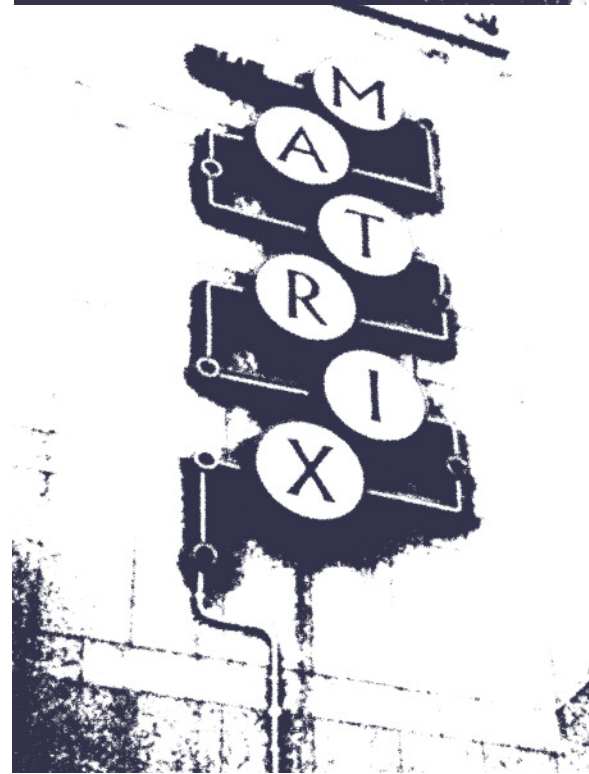
Shalom Dear Friends

We have had a busy winter season engaged in evangelism around the globe! We hope to publish results and highlights from our New York Summer Witnessing campaign and our campaign in Germany around the Women's Soccer World Cup in our next newsletter.

On the home-front, Jews for Jesus South Africa received permission to set up a literature table on the WITS campus outside the student canteen called *The Matrix*. We had an engaging book to give away titled *Isaiah 53* (published by *Chosen People Ministries*) which challenged the reader to consider what this important section of scripture is all about. We distributed all our copies and we witnessed to some of the curious unsaved students on the campus. Please pray for one Jewish student who discussed the Gospel with us that he would discover peace in Messiah.

My co-worker Marc travelled to Moody Bible Institute to join the training group for the New York Summer Campaign. Andrew Barron taught Jewish studies and imparted techniques of street evangelism. Teresa, the boys and myself were studying for three weeks in Portland, Oregon over the mid-year school holidays. This was also a good time to reconnect with American, British and Israeli colleagues and their families from the international branches studying with us. Please pray for us as we finish our assignments for these courses and apply them for the glory of Jesus' kingdom in our day to day work. I also had an opportunity to speak on the Feasts of Israel (using the Book of Ruth)



in two churches in the Northwest United States during my time there.

We have received our *Christus in die Pasga* (*Christ in the Passover*) book shipment and I am delighted and blessed that we now have this wonderful resource for our Afrikaans-speaking brothers and sisters. This is the first of our books published in this language!

We fielded a colourful "Walk-the-Talk" team for the 5km fun walk hosted near the end of July in Johannesburg. As we started the walk, the announcer came over the air and read "Jesus is Messiah" as he proclaimed what was written on our t-shirts! This was heard by many in the crowd, some of whom spoke with us on the walk, encouraging us, others no doubt having a gospel seed sown that day!

At the end of September we are planning to host Eckard Rabe in his one man play, *The Rabbi*. We will publish more details on this closer to the time.
