Shalom Haverim (friends),

I have just returned from an intense time in San Francisco meeting with our Jews for Jesus senior staff. I was encouraged by the reports of evangelism we have been doing throughout the world, especially in Israel and in India.



We received further feedback from our first Israel **"Behold Your God"** outreach centred in the Tel Aviv area. The Israeli media caught on to what was unfolding and interviewed the Israeli branch leader, Dan Sered, on prime time breakfast television. (You can watch this amazing interview on www.youtube.com/watch?v=DKzZgNlh4sM) Dan was able to clearly articulate the Messiahship of Jesus amongst our Jewish people. This programme is probably watched by over one million people in Israel every day! What a great opportunity for us to spread the gospel! If you are interested in serving as an evangelist (you would need to speak Hebrew) or as a steward (you only need to speak English for this position) on future Israel **"Behold Your God"** outreaches then please contact our local office.

The **Massah** project ("Journey") is another evangelistic outreach which is geared towards university-aged students who want to do a short term mission trip to Israel and India. They spend six weeks learning about Israel and Israeli culture and history, they do evangelism in Israel and then they leave for India where they do a month of evangelism on-the-go as they travel from place to place. This year they were able to meet many Israelis who travel to India as a destination of choice. Many of them are fresh out of three years of military service and are

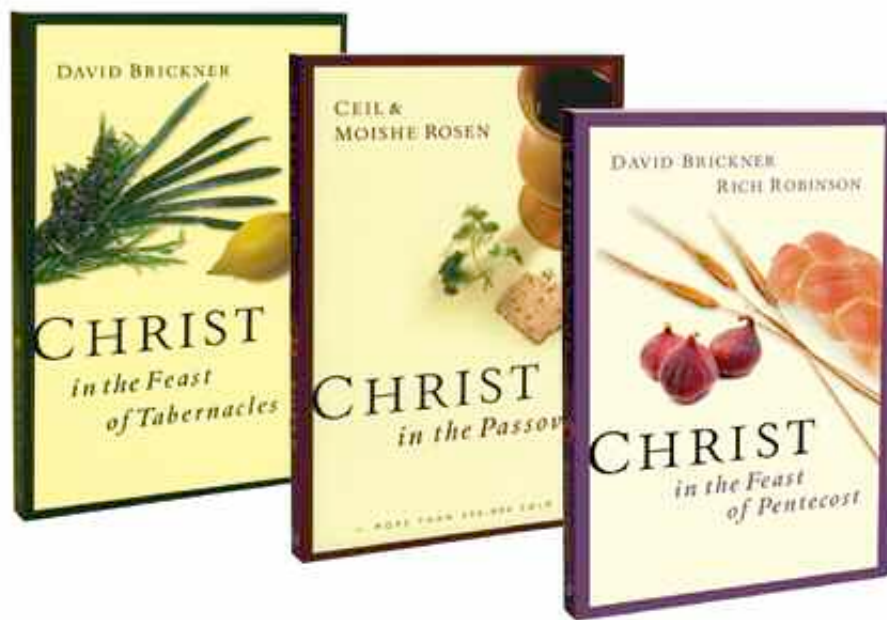
