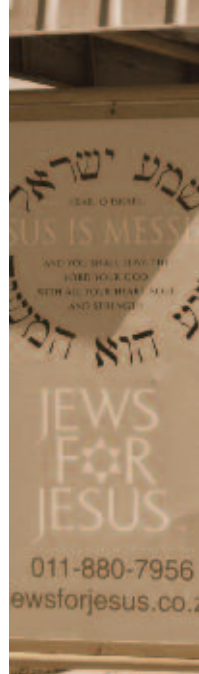
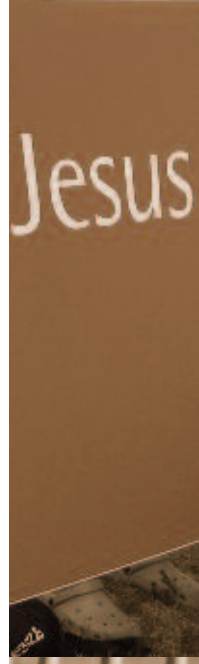
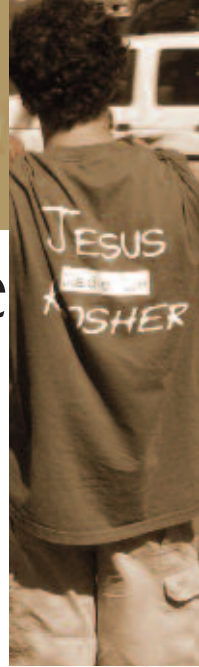
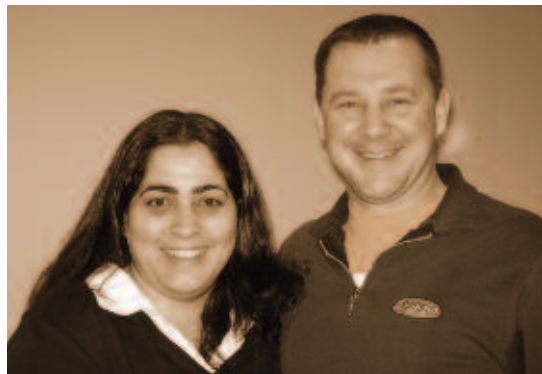
Shalom Friends in Messiah,

At Jews for Jesus, we brought in 2008 with an intense two weeks of evangelism. Our Living Waters outreach in Cape Town began right after Christmas and wrapped up in the first week of January. In December we had a joyous end of year Hanukkah celebration at *Congregation Beit Y'shua* as we celebrated the Festival of Lights and lifted up the name of Jesus, the Light of the World with over 200 people who had committed to be with us that evening.
