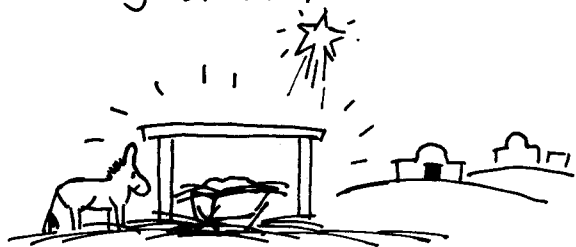


"But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes, we are healed."

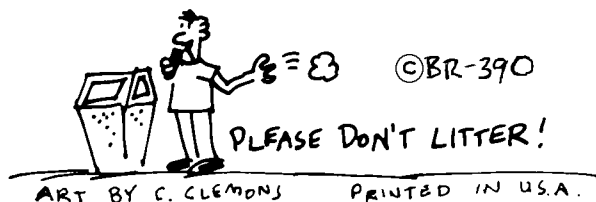

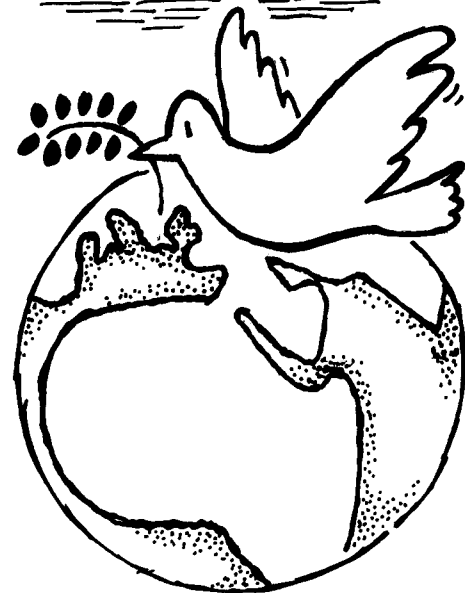

People say they want "peace" when they are trying to sleep with a loud party going on next door...



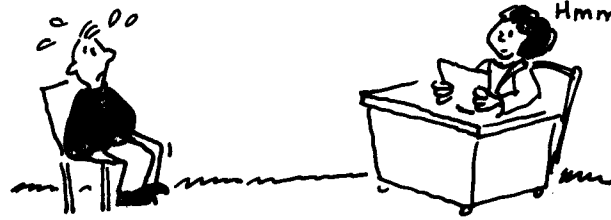
... they really want quiet.

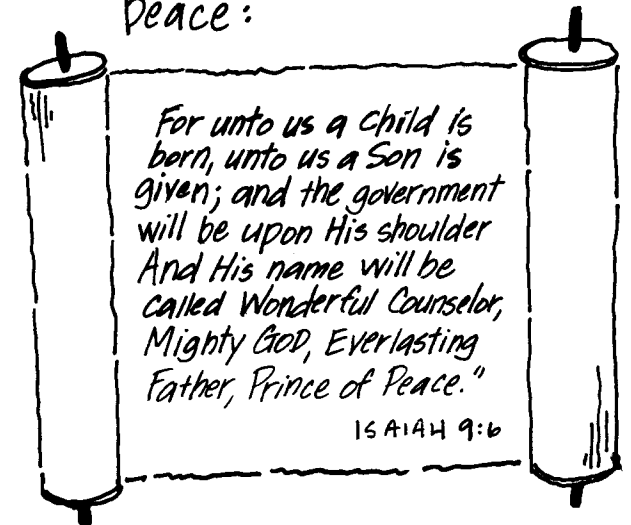


So where can we look for a lasting peace that works for everyone?
